3. GREEN PROJECT AND AGRICULTURE

Green Project

Green Project executed several agricultural works in Lebanon. It rehabilitated some areas in dounams and executed roads. It also computed the damages caused to agricultural lands in July-August 2006. The Bent-Jbayl Caza registered the peak of damages (40-45%). The following table shows the evolution of Green Project works between 2006 and 2007.

There was a progression between 2006 and 2007 in Framers' works (40.6%), number of villages where work was done (9.34%), rehabilitated area in dounams (91.4%), walls in square meters (22.0%), fruitful saplings (21.8%), fence in meters (6.3%) and paid amounts in thousands LBP (41.7%). While there was a decrease in concrete tanks in cubic meters (-22.5%) and vine columns (-90.8%).
