## **Green project**

Green Project undertook several agricultural works in Lebanon.



In 2009, Green Project spends 5,470 million LBP to finance 1,041 farmers and agricultural activities in 572 villages. These activities are:

- Reworked area: 4,506 dounams.
- Support walls: 91,082 square meters.
- Irrigation channels: 14,167 meters.
- Concrete tanks 17,166 CM.
- Vine colums: 5,170.
- Tank perforation 128,875 CM.
- Fruitful saplings: 20,001 .
- Fence: 26,919 meters.
- Modern irrigation: 151 dounams.

#### Agriculture


Lebanese foreign trade of agricultural products consists of imports and exports of vegetable products, meats, bran, meal and oxlip of animal, milk products, eggs and honey.

Foreign trade balance of agricultural products is equal to (2,010,843 million LBP). It is negative for most items except for eggs (5,096).



In million LBP, fruit trees, olives and nuts are the most exported (48.4%). While the most imported product is meat (29.8%). The trade balance register the higher deficit for meat (32.2%) and an excedent for eggs (0.3%).



### Agricultural census 1997-2007 – Selected indicators

The Ministry of Agriculture conducted the Agricultural census for the years 1997-2007. Its results display the production and foreign trade of vegetal and animal products.



The decade 1997-2007 witnessed an increase in value on all scale:

- Animal and vegetal production: + 44.8%.
- Animal and vegetal exports: + 188.5%.
- Animal and vegetal imports: + 23.0%.

#### Agricultural census 1998-2007 – Vegetal products

Most vegetal products production increased in value except for Corneas (-12.0) and nuts (-2.1%).
